Stage 1: General Thug Attack Concealment, not limiter

A dasturdly thug is bobbing and weaving behind your favorite no shoot. At the buzzer shoot T1 with 3 while avoiding the no shoot. Move to cover and pie T2 & T3 with 3 each.

Stage 2: No Shoot Hell Concealment Not Limiter

At the buzzer engage 1 single thug (T1) with 3 shots while avoiding the swinging no shoots in front and back of him.

Stage 3: Retreat In The Park (By Marc Schwartz) Concealment, not limiter

String 1

You bump into Mr. Nutjob (T1) and he draws on you. At the buzzer starting standing even with T1, draw and shoot T1 with 3 to the body Zwhile retreating to cover. "Damn Body Armor" from cover shoot T1 again with 2 to the head then reholster (for safety reasons) with out reloading.

String 2

Moving up to remove T1's weapon, you see Mr. Nutjobs buddies. At the buzzer T5 begins moving towards you from 20 yds. Engage T2 while moving backwards to cover at 12 yds. At cover pie left and shoot T3 and T4 (reload at slide lock). Then shoot T5 before he gets to you (and becomes a wall shot). THEN shoot T6 the tennis ball at 7 yds until you hit or run out of ammo. T2 thru 5 get 3 each. If you run out of ammo on T6 there is a failure to neutralize penalty.

Stage 4: Garage Assault & Robbery Concealment, not limiter

You come across thugs beating and robbing a midget (the baby) near a concrete column. Starting 2 yds from the column at the buzzer draw and shoot T1 on the left of column freestyle with 3. T1 shoots your weak arm. Pie right of the column and shoot T3 with 3 then T4 that is moving away from you (while shooting) with 3 strong hand only.

Stage 5: Get Off Line And Line Them Up! (By Mike Birdsong) Concealment, limiter

T1 thru T4 are in a 45 degree angle 1 yd apart. Start in front of T1, at the buzzer side step to the left while drawing and shoot T1 with 2 shots, then while moving shoot T2 - T4 with 2 each to the body.

Stage 6: Level 3 Shoot Off Concealment, no limiter

2 shooters start at 5 yds. At buzzer, move to barrel at the 7 yd line, with strong hand knock empty ammo box off barrel, then draw and shoot T1 with 2 shots to the body at 2 yds. T2 is a balloon in the center of a center cut out target at 25 yds. First to shoot the balloon wins and moves and moves up. The winners of each fight are then matched against other winners until last man standing. Tony Pierce won this competition in a dazzling display of gun handling and marksmanship on the last fight.
