Stage 1: Save the hostages! Home invasion ver. 1.0 concealment, not limited, semi-blind stage

Start with 6 in the gun. On the move left and forward engage T1 at 7 yards, move right and forward to engage T2 at 10 yards. Reload behind cover and engage T3-T5 around walls at ranges 3-7 yards. T3-T5 around wall at ranges 3 - 7 yards.
were randomized with 2 NT's for each shooter.

Stage 2: There's no place like home, it's time to relocate! Home invasion ver. 2.0

Concealment, Not Limited, Semi-Blind stage
Engage T1 with 3 to chest, then T2 at 10 yards and T3 at 6 yards with 2 to body from the left side of cover. Move left and forward to engage T4 -T6 through the window at 8 to 10 yards, two each, avoid NT.

Stage 3: We're not happy until you're happy! Concealment, not limited

Engage T1 with 3 body, 2 yards. Engage T2, 10 yards with 2 each from cover while moving left. Engage T3 at 5 yards on the move left while avoiding NT and T4 at 10 yards through the window. Move past cover to gain a viewpoint on T5 11 yards, and move again to engage T6 at 12 yards. T2-6 get two shots each.

Stage 4: Misery loves... well, it loves misery... No concealment, not limited

T1-T6 with NT's mixed in, from 3 to 6 yards. 2 to body followed by 1 head shot. Sounds easy, but isn't.

One lesson learned tonight is that the palms outward universal gesture of helplessness does not deflect bullets. Getting down is a much better idea.
